# EPPOC Draft Minutes Wednesday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025, 9:30-11:30 am

November meeting speaker: Captain Tim Sturm, Calaveras Cold Case Task Force Team Leader, Calaveras County Sheriff's Office – Captain Sturm has been with the Sheriff's Office for twenty-seven years. Captain Sturm and others in the Department started a cold case task force in 2020. They learned that modern DNA testing might be able to identify some of these remains that previously could not be done. Their initial focus was the remains of the Wilseyville killings, that has been extended to other cold cases including homicides. There are one thousand specimens all labeled from the Wilseyville crypt. Specimens are sent to private sector genealogy investigators who can match the unknown DNA with relatives who have recorded their DNA in public records. He gave several examples of specific cases. His presentation is *excellent!* I highly recommend watching it from 02:00 to 14:55 in the first video.
