• Speaker this month: Teresa Hitchcock, Calaveras County Chief Executive Officer – Teresa explained that Calaveras County has a different charter than some other Counties in California and therefore have different rules they must follow. Teresa then explained the annual Budget in detail, the various components of the County Strategic Plan, the specifics of the new Animal Services building, and the plan for the new District Attorney facility. All these elements of her talk were supported by a wonderful PowerPoint.
